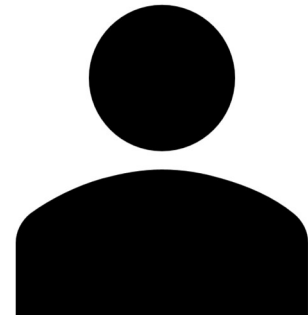

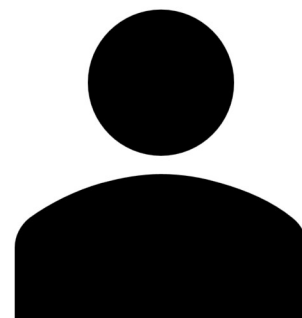
I would be glad if I can work with AStA in the department of anti-racism, making the University environment friendly and welcoming for all. I am attaching my application with this email for the nomination.
